

Preventive care medications

Human Immunodeficiency Virus Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis medications available at \$0

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Under the health reform law (Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act), most private health plans must cover certain preventive care medications at 100% — without charging a copay, coinsurance or deductible.

In response to this law and a United States Preventive Services Task Force (USPSTF) recommendation, your plan offers coverage of Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) at \$0 when used for prevention.

If you have a higher chance of becoming infected with HIV but are not yet infected, the preventive care medications below are available at \$0.

Most pharmacy benefit plans also cover these medications at a normal copay or coinsurance when they are being used for the treatment of HIV infection.

HIV PrEP medications currently available at \$0

Drug name
emtricitabine-tenofovir disoproxil fumarate 200-300mg tablet (generic Truvada) – Truvada available if unable to take generic
tenofovir disoproxil fumarate 300mg tablet (generic Viread) – Viread available if unable to take generic
Apretude ER 600mg-3ml injection
Descovy 200-25mg tablet
